








BETTER AND BETTER.



DETAILS ADD UP.

There's an elegance about our homes that reflects the quality you'll find in each and every one of them. When you put details first, you build homes that last. Authenticity is terribly important to me. So we always insist on using real materials. Our crown moulding is plaster not pre-fab like others use. The exteriors of our homes are clad in real limestone not concrete made to look like stone. All my bricks are "tumbled bricks" so the texture looks authentic. It feels real - something that has endured and will endure. Our kitchens feature waterfall marble or granite counters. They're hand made and show not even a hint of a seam - so your eye appreciates the smooth flowing line of the hand-selected materials. We've now taken to using sliding glass doors in all our homes. We used to install French doors leading onto our decks, but the doors took up valuable space. Our new sliding glass doors allows more light to enter the room and provides a better seal against the elements. Even the features you don't see add up to the overall quality - like our new quieter heating systems. After all, it's lots of little things that make a house more livable.



There always has to be an elegant solution to the challenges we face in building our homes. It might be in the engineering. It might be in the selection of materials. Look at our windows, for example. See the natural division between the individual panels of glass? That's called a "muntin bar". It's something that was in vogue over 100 years ago and it suggests an era of craftsmanship rarely seen today.

All my Dunpar homes have real muntin bars, not just a piece of aluminium inserted in the glass. It's a little more expensive, but in my opinion, well worth it. Speaking of elegant solutions, you'll notice that with a Dunpar home you enter from ground level - there are no external steps. Why? Because we've internalized the staircase. And the overall gain in space is simply amazing. There are literally hundreds of elegant solutions in each of my homes. I believe in building from the details up.
